To all contacts in the Somerset Cricket League.

1. Transfers

- a) The transfer deadline for transfers between clubs in the SCL closes after the first Saturday in August (no transfers after August 4 2018). *Transfer forms are available on the League's website.*
- b) Transfers between clubs in the SCL and the WEPL pyramid are also subject to the August 4 deadline.
- c) Teams playing in the WEPL pyramid (ie. **all teams** in the SCL; B & D; GCL; WCL) are subject to the transfer rules. They need a transfer to move from any club to any other club in the pyramid during the season.
- d) At all times, **players of any age** who are allowed to play in the SCL under ECB 'all age' restriction regulations must also follow the Transfers Directive as shown above.

2. Return of Trophies

Trophies won in Season 2017. I wish to remind clubs that won a trophy in 2017 that they should now make arrangements to return them. Rule 9 applies – 9. TROPHIES. Perpetual trophies shall be returned to the Honorary Secretary by 31st August each year. Trophies are to be returned in the same condition as received and any loss or damage to such trophies shall be borne by the club holding the trophy. Trophies can be returned to me or any other member of the Management Committee or to the Centre of Excellence (SCB Office) at the County Ground, Taunton.

4. Ashbrittle CC.
