IMPORTANT DROUGHT ADVICE FOR CRICKET CLUBS

This season has been hot and very dry in many parts of England and Wales. We have worked with our partner the Grounds Management Association (GMA) to publish new guidance on:

- 1 Watering Effectively and Efficiently
- 2 Watering under drought restrictions
- 3 Working safely in hot and sunny conditions

This includes guidance on what to do if you are under a Temporary Use Ban (hosepipe ban) or other drought restriction.

Clubs could be at risk of prosecution and fines if they are not watering in accordance with the law under Temporary Use Bans.

All clubs should read the guidance and act on it. Please make sure that your grounds manager has access to the link and the resources.

The guidance is on the GMA Toolkit for Cricket our free knowledge resource for cricket grounds managers.
