

Dear Clubs and Leagues of Somerset,

The start of the communication highlights the latest position of the recreational game and the second part covers “Getting your Clubhouse and Grounds ready for Step 4” has been asked regularly by clubs and I have included the details below:

ECB have finalised [guidance on preparing your clubhouse and grounds](#) for when recreational clubs can return to playing cricket in England.

The date of which, as outlined, is still to be confirmed.

The Government position has however, been updated to allow the opening of bars and food/drink facilities. Clubs, if they wish to, can begin offering this from 4th July. Within the latest guidance, you can seek information on how to safely offer this to members and visitors.
